Objectives of the Course:

This course will explore how improvisation can be used both as a performance structure and research method for the understanding of movement and in relation to other media. With the use of other artistic media (music, visual arts), text, voice objects students will be introduced to a world of possibilities that will help them transcend their own boundaries. Through taking risks, making choices and responding to challenges, students will gain movement awareness, experience various forms and aesthetics of improvisation.

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

1. Perform in the moment, making instant choices and challenging themselves creatively and structurally.
2. Transcend old habits and transcend their boundaries.
3. Practice the technique and aesthetics of improvisation.
4. Integrate other artistic media into their dance.
5. Collaborate in partners and groups.
6. Experience and analyze improvisation as an intact performance genre.
7. Use improvisation as a research tool.
