Objectives of the Course:

The main objectives of the course are to:

- make students aware of the new trends in EU social policy for local social development
- provide students with knowledge in social planning theory and fundamental knowledge for developing holistic plans of Social Service Programs
- thoroughly discuss the models, standards, stages and tools in planning social services
- cover in detail all aspects of Social Networks and Service networking (the nature and characteristics, models of networking, building and maintaining relationships)
- discuss a model of Service Network for local social policy development
- introduce state-of-the art in the area of Social Work in networking and HR protection of service users

- design and develop planned applications using available social work knowledge
- enhance strategic and operational planning with regard to local authority social policy development and Service optimization through networking

- research in state-of-the art areas in local social policy and in social networking
