Objectives of the Course:

The course aims are to make the students become aware of: issues concerning people with disabilities, and of ways multi-method intervention in social work from a contemporary holistic, interdisciplinary approach and search.

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

- Determine the meaning of disability.
- Familiarize with the various categories of persons with disabilities and their special educational needs.
- Investigate the temporal evolution of the phenomenon of diversity and disability and the attitudes and perceptions of society for people with disabilities and finally,
- Determine the interventions of social work at all levels.

Course Contents:

The issues that will be covered include:

1. Introduction, Background - Definitions and impact of social reality in the temporal approach to disability.
2. Categories of persons with disabilities.
3. Attitudes and perceptions of society for people with disabilities-Social Inequalities.
4. Attitude of people with disabilities and their families, Social Work Intervention.
5. Special education, interdisciplinary approach - from exclusion to empowerment and integration.
6. Community and people with disabilities - Care Networks - Social Capital - Resources. Social Work Intervention.
7. Vocational rehabilitation - Law and bio-ethical issues, rights of persons with disabilities and Social Work.

Teaching Methods:

Lectures, Presentations, Group discussion, Assignments and films.
