Course Objectives:

This is the second of a two-semester sequence on psychological interventions and techniques. This course aims to familiarize students with the clinical application of cognitive behavioral approaches, and the process of clinical case conceptualization from a cognitive behavioral perspective. Students will be introduced to the main tenets of cognitive theories and the major techniques used in assessment, interviewing and the psychotherapy process, using illustrations of clinical material and role-playing exercises. The utility and efficacy of cognitive behavioral models of treatment will also be evaluated and discussed.

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

- 1. Show an understanding of the main cognitive behavioral intervention models.
- 2. Develop knowledge of the main tenets and theories of cognitive behavioral therapy.
- 3. Develop familiarity with assessment and cognitive behavioral treatment techniques.
- 4. Approach clinical material and develop case formulations using a cognitive behavioral perspective.
- 5. Critically evaluate the efficacy of cognitive behavioral treatment models.



Course Content:

- 1. Assessment and clinical interviewing techniques
- 2. Techniques of Cognitive Behaviour Therapy approaches
- 3. Treatment planning and case conceptualization
- 4. Efficacy of CBT approaches to psychotherapy
