Course Objectives:

The main objectives of the course are to:

- Demonstrate experience in the art, cultural and creative field.
- Recognize potential professional career paths.
- Attain professional experience in a self-defined direction in line with potential paths of developing as a professional contemporary artist, in arts education, exhibition production, residencies, museum work, performance, research and non-governmental organizations.
- Enhance students' communications skills.

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

1. Identify what area of professional practice they are interested to pursue. Students can either carry out a twenty full day placement or combine different experiences.
2. Evaluate the experience and use it to inform subsequent practices and professional directions.
3. Prepare for the practicalities that are involved in pursuing and maintaining a Fine Art practice in the professional world.
4. Appraise what working in the professional arts and culture field entails. Identify own strengths and weaknesses.

Course Content:

Placement- (20 full days --150 hours of work experience-- which can be in one placement/area or a combination of experiences in different contexts- artist assistant, theatre, museum, gallery, art education, residence, photographer, video etc).
Write up and prepare a portfolio in relation to the experience
