Objectives of the Course:

- To prepare the student to write and report news packages for radio.
- To teach students to identify, research, write and produce news.
- To acquire reporting skills.
- To learn how to take an interview.

Learning Outcomes:

2. Comprehend the differences between electronic and print journalism.
3. Be able to write short pieces for radio.
4. Be able to understand the basics of creating a news magazine for radio broadcasting.

6. Have improved her/his researching and reporting skills.

Course Contents:

1. Characteristics of broadcasting news.
2. Introduction to many of the skills needed in a radio station and radio news organization.
3. Writing and reporting news and feature stories in a variety of short and long radio formats.
4. Organizing a news magazine.
5. Developing a personal style in Newswriting.

Teaching Methods:

Meetings with the student to supervise and guide his progress in the paper he has to write.

Assessment Methods:

Preparing news reports and presenting them.
