It is an intermediate-advanced level technique class where execution is considerably more refined with use of an extensive dance movement vocabulary a strong performance quality.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Practice secure posture and correct weight placement while performing movements of increased complexity.
2. Perform an increased range of movements with co-ordination of the whole body, well stretched legs and articulated footwork.
3. Demonstrate with ease complex sequences which demand the combination of advanced vocabulary.
4. Perform with an acute sensitivity to the rhythmical structures, melody, texture and dynamic expression of the music.
5. Express an assured and confident performance with a high level of personal engagement.
