### **Objectives of the Course:**

The aim of this course is to enable students to develop geographical and environmental fieldwork techniques and skills in a location in Cyprus

**Course Content:**

This course is based around a residential field course which includes staff-led work along with student-led work, which may include group working. The module introduces themes and techniques for field work and will cover a range of topics that will include geology, geomorphology, ecology, climate change, settlement patterns, land use issues, cultural geography, tourism impacts, water resource issues and energy supply and demand. Historical, current and future aspects will be addressed in selected topics.
