Course Objectives:

The main objectives of the course are to:

- introduce students to a variety of texts by women authors
- develop the students' capacity for analysis, synthesis and interpretation
- foster critical reasoning in reading and writing about exemplary literary texts
- develop research skills appropriate to the field demonstrated in coherent assignments and projects

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

- analyze various literary texts in fiction and non-fiction by women writers
- independently analyze literature in English paying special attention to the role of gender
- orally transmit an understanding of these texts in English
- use a variety of critical approaches, including a feminist one, in reading and writing about literature
- formulate interpretations of literary texts in coherent research papers which reflect genre, thematic and cultural diversity in relation to gender
