## **Course Objectives:**

The course introduces students to various models/applications of bi/multilingual education. Students familiarize themselves with current research on methodology and study real examples from other European countries. Students identify examples of good practice in Europe and reflect on possible applications in the local context. The different models of cooperation among language and non-language teachers are examined and strengths/ weaknesses of the various models are identified. Students learn how bilingual/multilingual models can be improved to support language learning (CLIL methodology/ Content and Language Integrated Learning).

- Identify good materials for bilingual programmes
- Propose appropriate assessment criteria
