Objectives of the Course:

The project must demonstrate not only knowledge of the subject but also proper research techniques and referencing. The student will be expected to produce a properly researched and referenced project of approximately 6000 words. The student will be under constant supervision with a faculty member who has an appropriate specialisation
