Course Objectives:

The main objectives of the course are to:

- Provide students with both the theoretical and practical knowledge of the law related to public procurement.
- Introduce and develop the concepts of public authorities, public contracts, tenders, and tenderers/economic operators.
- Introduce the legislation and case law concerning the selection of tenderers and award of public contracts.
- Provide students with an introduction to the study of public procurement law in Cyprus and the European Union.

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

- Explain and describe the notions of contracting authorities and contracting entities.
- Recognise and appraise the system introduced by the Directives 2014/23/EU, 2014/24/EU and 2014/25/EU concerning public contracts of services, works and goods.
- Assess the rules and principles governing preparation and interpretation of tender documents.
- Evaluate and interpret the procedures for procuring a public contract.



- Illustrate and discuss the rules governing evaluation of tenderers and awarding a contract.
- Explain and appraise the rules for the judicial review of awarded public contracts.
- Criticise and assess the rules of Cypriot law of public procurement

- Criteria for award of a contract
- Annulling a procedure
- Principles of judicial review
- Material and immaterial breaches
- Cypriot Law of procurement: The Tenders Review Authority and recourse to the Administrative and Supreme Court
