Objectives of the Course:

The main objective of this course is to study the law relating to the administration of trusts, in order to understand, *inter alia*, how trustees are appointed, removed or may retire as well as the powers and duties of trustees.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Examine the purposes of Charitable Trusts.
2. Explain the reasons why trusts for non-charitable purposes are generally invalid.
3. Discuss the rules regarding the appointment, retirement and removal of trustees vis-à-vis their powers and duties.
4. Assess the fiduciary nature of trusteeship.
5. Analyse the ways in which breach of trust may arise and describe the various remedies for breach.
6. Discuss how trusts may be varied.
7. Examine the nature and use of equitable remedies.
8. Examine the important role played by equity in the development of English law and in the law of countries whose legal systems are based on the English law.
