Objectives of the Course

The main objectives of the course are to:

1. Develop awareness of the specifics of the instruments of the wind band.
2. Provide a comprehensive overview of the issues pertaining to the creation and direction of school wind bands
3. Develop the ability to choose appropriate repertoire for youth wind bands
4. Develop the ability to plan, organize and conduct rehearsals and concerts
5. Broaden the students' repertoire range with works composed or arranged for wind band.

Learning Outcomes

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

1. Select suitable musicians for the youth band
2. Select appropriate repertoire
3. Arrange the musical material according to the youth band
4. Demonstrate the appropriate control of band intonation
5. Plan, organize and conduct rehearsals and concerts
6. Apply phrasing and articulation efficiently.

Course Contents

- Organization of the various school concert bands
- Individual lessons for members of the school's band orchestra
- Arrangement of selected pieces for various school band settings
- Theoretical fundamentals of playing wind musical instruments
- Methods of teaching the art of playing in a concert band

Learning Activities and Teaching Methods

Lessons: Practical Exercises, to play pieces for the Orchestra

Assessment Methods

Homework, Arranging of one piece for Concert Band (Midterm), Final Exam Project
