Objectives of the Course

This course is intended to be taken concurrently with MUS 468: Advanced Applied Primary Study IV and MUS 490: Senior Recital. It provides the necessary allocation of additional individual instruction and practice time in the student's course load to prepare for the final graduation recital in the Classical Performance concentration.

Learning Outcomes

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

1. Illustrate the appropriate performing skills on their major instrument
2. Formulate and adhere to a constructive practice routine
3. Perform publicly and appraise the experience of performance
4. Evaluate themselves with regards to playing ability in relation to the expected performing standards
5. Illustrate a sense of stage presence and communication with an audience
6. Plan, prepare, and produce full scale recitals

Course Contents

The instructor will develop, with the student, an individualized repertory that will be studied. This course provides two hours of weekly individual instruction in the student's primary instrument, which supplements the one hour received as part of MUS 478: Advanced Primary Study IV.

Learning Activities and Teaching Methods

Individual (one-to-one) lessons; studio classes; public performances; intense private practice.

Assessment Methods

Graded individual lessons; final examination by faculty jury.

Required Textbooks/Reading

Students are required to purchase all etude books, repertory, etc., as assigned by their instructors.
