The main objectives of the course are to:

- Provide advanced individualized and group instruction on his/her primary performance medium
- Develop student's technical and expressive skills
- Help students become familiar with appropriate stylistic habits
- Allow the student to gain experience playing in solo and ensemble situations and in public performance
- Prepare students for their graduation recital
- (The course may, at the instructor's discretion, be taken as a Major Elective by students who are not following the Performance Concentration)

- Formulate and adhere to a constructive practice routine
- Perform publicly and appraise the experience of performance

Course Content:

- Weekly one-to-one instruction
- Weekly Studio classes

- Solo jury examination
