Course Description:

This is the last of a four-semester practicum sequence. The course will function primarily as a forum for peer supervision, clinical consultations and personal and professional development for clinical psychology trainees placed at various sites including community mental health clinics and other social service agencies where clinical psychology is applied. Emphasis will continue to be given on deepening insight and self-reflective skills via the therapeutic process, while undergoing supervision training to develop basic supervisory skills.

Objectives and Learning Outcomes:

- Students will continue to conceptualize and formulate clinical cases.
- Students will continue to perform differential diagnosis.
- Students will continue to demonstrate knowledge of professional and ethical standards.
- Students will continue to maintain client records.
- Students will continue to conduct individual and group psychotherapy (when applicable).
- Students will continue to demonstrate basic clinical skills.
- Students will continue to develop treatment plans.
- Students will continue to engage in self-reflection to identify potential emotional barriers to treatment.
- Students will seek peer consultation and supervision for clinical impasses from each other.
- Students will provide peer consultations and supervision to each other.
