Course Objectives:

This is the second of a three-semester practicum seminar sequence. This semester the course will function primarily as a forum for peer supervision, clinical consultations and personal development for clinical psychology trainees placed at various sites such as community clinics, social service agencies and other settings where clinical psychology is applied. Emphasis will be given on evaluation and intake assessments of clients, history taking, case formulation and therapy process.

Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

1. Students will conceptualize and formulate clinical cases.
2. Students will conduct individual and group psychotherapy (where applicable).
3. Students will develop treatment plans.
4. Students will engage in self-reflection to identify potential emotional barriers to treatment.
5. Students will learn to seek peer consultation and supervision for clinical impasses.
6. Students will learn to provide supervision to peers and deliver feedback effectively.
