### Course Description:

This is the first of two courses in psychometric assessment aiming to introduce and train students on the usage of psychometric tests in clinical practice. Emphasis is also given in the communication of results via Clinical Psychology Reports.

### Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes:

- Introduce students to the theory and practice of psychometric testing (including techniques of developing, standardizing tests and inventories used in Clinical Psychology)
- Review major psychometric tests used in child assessment
- Enhance students' knowledge regarding the contribution of psychometric tests in clinical assessment

- The nature of intelligence
- Ethics of testing
- WISC III- Presentation of the test
- Analysis and Interpretation of results
- Psychometric profiles as derived from WISCIII results
- Introduction of supplementary tests (e.g., Wechsler Memory Tests, Ray Ostreith Complex Figures, WCST)
- Report Writing
