Course Description:

This is the second of two courses in psychometric assessment aiming to introduce and train students on the usage of psychometric tests in clinical practice. Emphasis is also given in the communication of results via Clinical Psychology Reports.

- train students in the administration of tests and in the interpretation of results of tests and inventories used in adult Clinical Psychology
- Train students in reporting psychometric results in clinical psychology reports and make suggestions about treatment.
