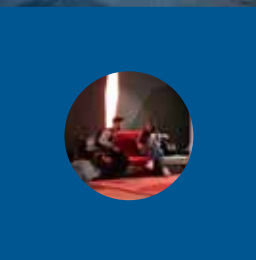

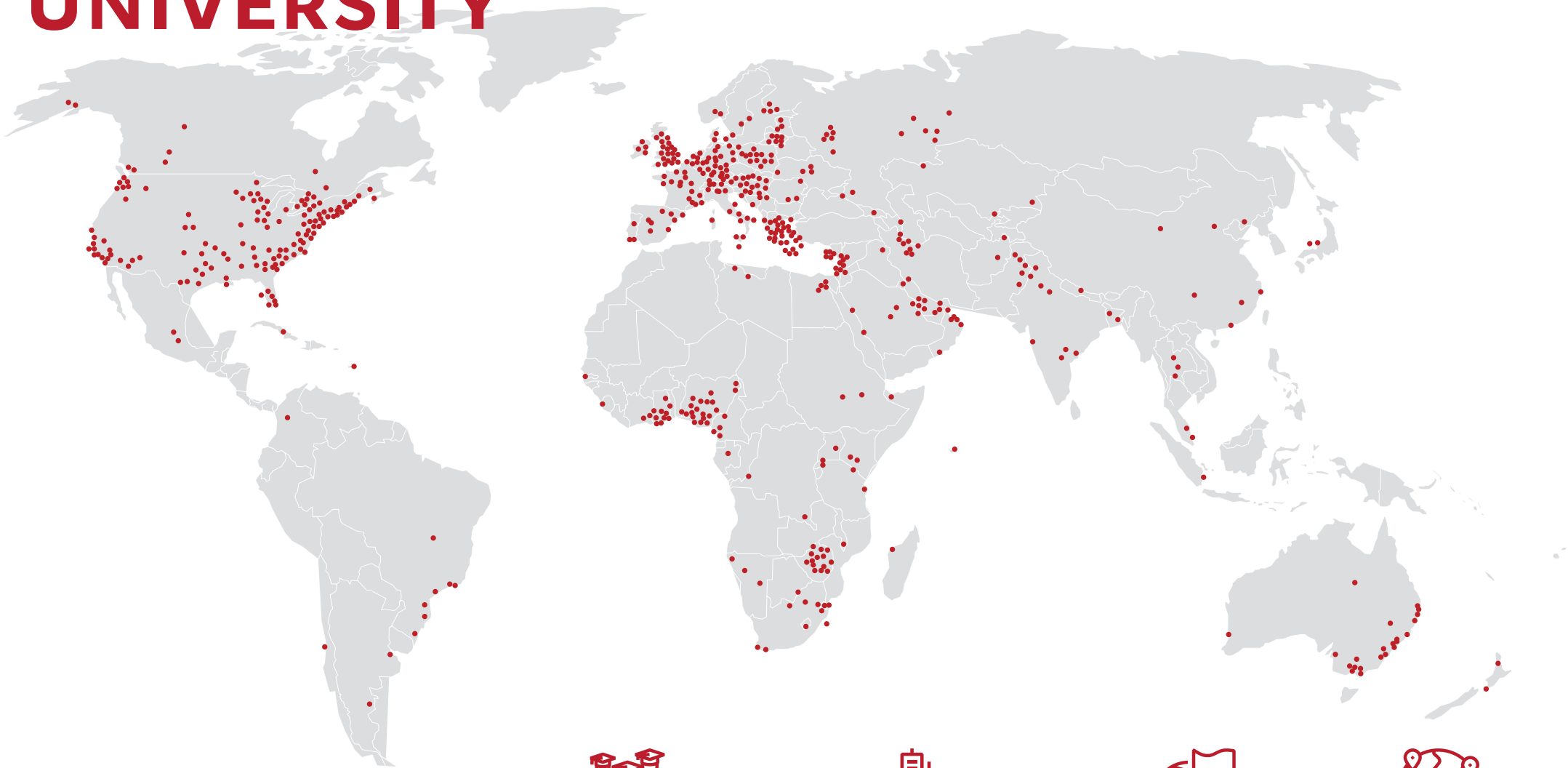

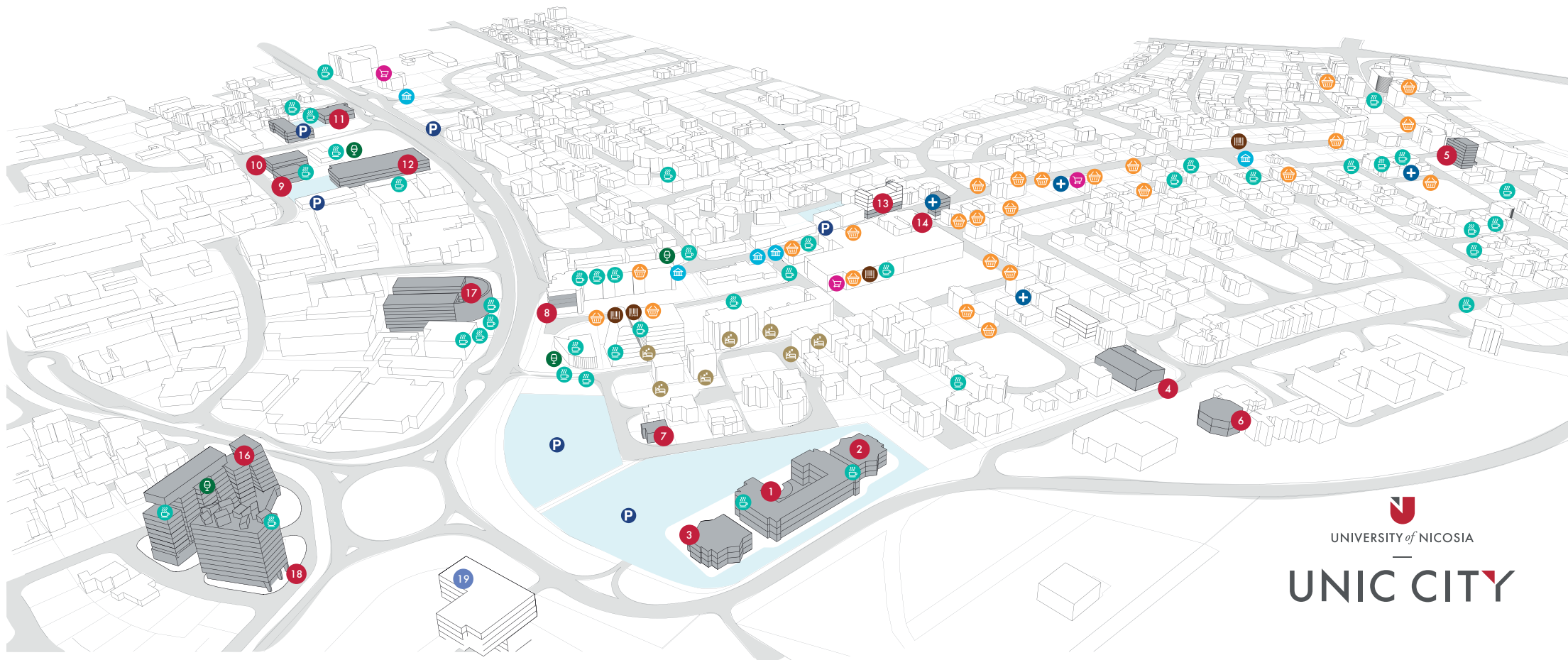

Coming from a Non-EU country

All non-EU students have to contact the International Admissions office at int.admissions@unic.ac.cy, the soonest, regarding the STUDENT ENTRY PERMIT application guidelines and deadlines.

Non-EU students will NOT be allowed to enroll for Erasmus at UNIC if they do not apply for a student Entry permit through the International Admissions office at UNIC prior to traveling to Cyprus.

Please do NOT use your Schengen visa for study purposes.

Coming from an EU country with an EU permit

Based on the latest information we had from our Civil Registry and Immigration Authorities, Non-EU students coming from an institution in an EU-Country who already have an EU permit, in order to get their residence permit they need to follow a procedure and submit all supporting documentation.

UPON ARRIVAL

Cyprus is served by two main international airports: Larnaca International Airport and Paphos International Airport. These modern hubs connect the island to destinations across Europe, the Middle East, and beyond.

Larnaca International Airport

Larnaca International Airport is the largest airport in Cyprus, located approximately 50 km (about 40 minutes by car) from Nicosia. It serves as the primary gateway to the island and is especially convenient for those traveling to the capital or eastern coastal regions. With a wide range of flights, it is the most accessible choice for international arrivals and departures.

Paphos International Airport

Paphos International Airport is situated on the western coast of Cyprus, about 140 km (around 90 minutes by car) from Nicosia. It primarily serves travelers heading to the historic city of Paphos, the surrounding resorts, or the Troodos Mountains. Though farther from the capital, it offers a convenient alternative for visitors exploring the western and central parts of the island.



AIRPORT PICK-UP

You can get to Nicosia from the airports by taxi, the Kapnos Airport Shuttle or Travel Express.



KAPNOS AIRPORT SHUTTLE

The Kapnos Shuttle offers transfers from Larnaca (€9) and Paphos (€12) airports to Kyrenias Avenue, Nicosia. From there, take a taxi to the University building of your interest or your hotel. Visit their website for details.

Reserve a taxi through the University for direct transfer at approximately €50 from Larnaca International Airport and €150 from Paphos International Airport.

You can rent your SmartBike anytime at any available official station in Nicosia.

Stations are available near UNIC (outside the main entrance of the University, Mall of Engomi, Starbucks Engomi, SIX and Triangle Residences).

TAXIS

Taxis can be relatively expensive if you are traveling on your own but they are a convenient and safe way to travel. Before you get in, you should ask the driver for the likely cost of your journey and ensure that you have enough cash with you. Taxis are available on the main road of the University.
