For instance, both Holyoak and Torremans, Intellectual Property Law (Oxford: OUP, 6th, 2010) and Cornish & Llewelyn, Intellectual Property (London: Sweet & Maxwell, 6th) cite paper on 'The Author Revived: Harmonisation without Justification" (European Intellectual Property Review") as recommended reading. The current edition of Grammatikaki-Alexiou, Papasiopi-Pasia and Vasilakakis on Private International Law (Sakkoulas: Thessaloniki, 5th 2012), cite book on the Rome I Regulation (Sakkoulas, 2009) as recommended reading. Work has further been considered by the Law Commission in England during its consultation work for legislative amendments (see Consultation Paper n. 209 of 2012 on Contempt of Court which cites and discusses paper on 'Contemp
