

Virtual Summer School ‘Sharing Good Practice in Multilingual and Intercultural Virtual Learning Spaces, 28 June - 9 July 2021

The Summer School is driven by the key themes of **interculturality** and **multilingualism** in the workplace with a focus on a variety of educational settings. The Summer School draws on **research-informed teaching** linked to practical, ‘real-life’ issues. It will provide a problem-solving based critical exploration of the experiences of different groups with focus on vulnerable, displaced and minority groups. Participants will be guided to complete **video group-projects**, and they will receive a **certificate of attendance** that includes a ‘**skills passport**’ that they will be able to use for employment-related purposes.

The event is delivered by the **Newcastle University**, UK and the **University of Nicosia**, Cyprus. It is funded by the Association of Commonwealth Universities ([ACU](https://www.acu.ac.uk/)).
