The tuition for the new students of the academic year 2026-2027 is based on the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), which provides a clear and transparent method of calculating the semester and yearly tuition (based on the number of ECTS registered per semester/year).

- The above instalments refer to all programmes excluding Medical School.
- International (non-EU) students (excl. Medical School) are required to pay the first semester's tuition before the commencement of classes. From the second semester onwards, the monthly instalments outlined above will be applicable.
- Medical School students are required to pay their semester fees in 4 monthly instalments, starting from the month classes begin. No down payment per semester is necessary. **New students will be required to pay a Seat Reservation Deposit of €5,500.** This deposit is refundable if they decide not to join. Those who join and withdraw, the refund policy applies accordingly. Those who join and continue, the deposit will be counted as the first instalment.

NOTES

1. Some students may need to take pre-university English courses (based on their score in the English Placement Test). These courses carry additional teaching hours per week and fewer ECTS and the tuition is based on the teaching hours. The above does not apply for Medical School.
2. Normal (full) attendance corresponds to 30 ECTS per semester (60 ECTS per year). For Medical School there is a compulsory full time attendance of 60 ECTS per academic year.
3. A variety of scholarships are available to full-time students, including academic merit scholarships, financial aid assistance, athletic scholarships and on-campus work-study programs. Different scholarship schemes apply for Medical School. More information about scholarships can be obtained from the Admissions Department.
4. Scholarships/financial aid apply to tuition and are deducted from the monthly instalments of each semester.
5. A late payment charge of 4% per year may be imposed on all overdue amounts until their full settlement. Students with outstanding financial obligations to the University will not be permitted to receive examination results, grades, transcripts, degree certificates or other documents, or enrol for the following semester until their accounts are settled.
