

ARTISTS' BOOKS COMPETITION

Department of Design and Multimedia of the University of Nicosia

Terms and conditions:

- Each art work will be evaluated separately and independently.
- The deadline for the submission of the Artist Books is Monday, 1 July 2019.
- For the purposes of the competition interested parties should submit the final artwork. The final books may be the result of a single technique or of a combination of different techniques, such as sculpture, painting, photography, etching or handwriting, a combination of experimental typography, sound, and image, a video, an animation inspired by the artist book and so on.
- Each submission must include, apart from the artwork itself, a written rationale supporting the creative proposal (the title and an explanatory text no longer than 200 words).
- Following the submission of the artworks, participants grant the Organiser (the University of Nicosia) the right to publish, exhibit, present and use part of or the whole artwork in any print and/or digital form.
- Submissions must include the following details: participants' full name, correspondence address, contact telephone number and email address. This information will not be disclosed to the jury. Each participant will be provided with a number, which will be given to the jury. Contestants' personal information will remain confidential and will only be revealed to the jury at the end of the competition.
- Each work of art submitted must be original, i.e., not a copy or a variation of another artist's work. The jury will decide on the authenticity of each submission.
- If the awarded participant is under 18 years old, the prize must be received in the presence of a parent or guardian.
- The consent for processing the personal data of the participants concerns both the needs of the specific competition, as well as, any other lawful purpose, including the receipt of information from the University of Nicosia and its affiliated institutions with respect to any degree programs, conferences and any professional and academic activities.
- The University of Nicosia reserves the right to revoke the competition, modify its duration or change any term at any time, if required, at the discretion of the committee. Any modifications will be announced either through an advertisement/announcement in the media or on the University website. These modifications will be binding on all participants and the University of Nicosia assumes no responsibility with respect to these modifications.
- The winners will be informed after the decision of the jury and will be notified via email.

- The jury's decision will be final.
- Awarded participants, in order to claim their scholarships, must meet the required admission criteria as determined by the University of Nicosia.
