Doctoral Dissertation:	<p>Solar Architecture in Cyprus: The aim of this research was to investigate the potential of the well-established principles of Passive Solar Design when applied to the specific cultural, economic and climatic contexts of Cyprus. The principal element of the study was the design, construction and monitored inhabitation of an Experimental Solar House in Lefkosia. In order to establish the parameters for this design detailed investigations for Cyprus were made on the climate, the terminal comfort, the energy economy, and the history of architecture. The best-known applications of passive systems are most suited for Cyprus. Through monitoring the Experimental Solar House from the 27/11/1999 until 18/12/2001, using computer data loggers. The results show that all heating requirements are satisfied by solar energy, while natural ventilation or ceiling fans meet all the cooling needs. The research concludes that Passive Solar Design may be successfully applied in the design of modern buildings in Cyprus.</p>
